The go-ahead goal was fired from the stick of Owen Heeney (assists to Sawyer Stephenson and Lincoln Gardner).

In the third period of action, the Leafs showed why they are the first place team in the CRHL U13 division adding three goals to their lead while holding Newcastle off the scoresheet. Nolan Burrows (assists to Sawyer Stephenson and Benjamin Simmons) set the stage with a goal in the second minute of play in the third stanza. Nolan Stephenson in combination with James Bulfon and Eli Cooper padded the Leaf advantage.
